ARCHAEOLOGY: ARCHAEOMAP PROJECT FOR MED SITES NETWORK

(ANSAmед) - PALERMO, DECEMBER 7 - The project 'Archaeomap', financed by the European Union, which will contribute for the creation of a network between coastal and underwater archaeological sites in the Mediterranean to allow a better exploitation of the cultural heritage of the Mediterranean area, will be presented to the public at 1800 local time at the headquarters of the Superintendence of the Sea, on Lungarini 9 street. In the morning, there will be a preliminary meeting between 18 international partners of the project coming from Italy, Tunisia, France, Algeria, Greece, Spain and Lebanon, coordinated by director of the Department for Sustainable Development of UNESCO, Mustafa El Tayeb. The partners will present the 11 coastal archaeological sites of the Mediterranean which will be taken as a model to define the common guide lines for the Mediterranean area. The objective is to allow a proper management of the cultural heritage in respect of the environment and as a resource of development for the respective territories: from the archaeological park of the Egadi Islands in the Channel of Sicily, to the site of Carthage in Tunisia, to the Pharos Island and Alexandria in Egypt, Tyre in Lebanon, Thessaloniki in Greece.(ANSAmед).
